INTRODUCTION

The primary purpose of this circular is to provide you with information regarding the proposed grant of the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate and the Extension Mandate (collectively the “Mandates”), the re-election of the retiring Directors and to seek your approval of the resolutions to these matters at the Annual General Meeting.

ISSUE MANDATE

At the Annual General Meeting, an ordinary resolution will be proposed to grant to the Directors a general and unconditional mandate to exercise the powers of the Company to allot, issue and deal with new Shares (including any sale or transfer of treasury Shares out of treasury) not exceeding 20% of total number of Shares in issue (excluding any treasury Shares) as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution at the Annual General Meeting. As at the Latest Practicable Date, a total of 125,235,000 Shares were in issue, and the Company did not have any treasury Shares. Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the Issue Mandate to the Directors and on the basis that no Shares will be issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed under the Issue Mandate to issue a maximum of 25,047,000 Shares.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

REPURCHASE MANDATE

At the Annual General Meeting, an ordinary resolution will be proposed to grant to the Directors a general and unconditional mandate to exercise all powers of the Company to repurchase, on the Stock Exchange, or on any other stock exchange on which the Shares may be listed, Shares not exceeding 10% of the total number of Shares in issue (excluding any treasury Shares) as at the date of passing of the relevant resolution at the Annual General Meeting. Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors and on the basis that no Shares will be issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 12,523,500 Shares.

Under the Listing Rules, the Company is required to give to its Shareholders all information which is reasonably necessary to enable Shareholders to make an informed decision as to whether to vote for or against the resolution in respect of the Repurchase Mandate at the Annual General Meeting. An explanatory statement for such purpose is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

The Company may cancel such repurchased Shares or hold them as treasury Shares, subject to market conditions and the Group's capital management needs at the relevant time of the repurchases.

For any treasury Shares deposited with Central Clearing and Settlement System used within the market system of Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited ("CCASS"), the Company shall (i) procure its broker not to give any instructions to Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited to vote at general meetings of the Company for the treasury Shares deposited with CCASS; and (ii) in the case of dividends or distributions, withdraw the treasury Shares from CCASS, and either re-register them in its own name as treasury Shares or cancel them, in each case before the record date for the dividends or distributions, or take any other measures to ensure that it will not exercise any shareholders' rights or receive any entitlements which would otherwise be suspended under the applicable laws if those Shares were registered in its own name as treasury Shares.

EXTENSION MANDATE

In addition, an ordinary resolution will also be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to extend the Issue Mandate by an addition of an amount representing the total number of Shares repurchased under the Repurchase Mandate.

The Repurchase Mandate and the Issue Mandate would expire at the earliest of: (a) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; or (b) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles or the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands to be held; or (c) revocation or variation by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in a general meeting prior to the next annual general meeting of the Company.

RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

Pursuant to Article 84(1) of the Articles, at each annual general meeting, one-third of the Directors for the time being (or if their number is not a multiple of three, then the number nearest to but not less than one-third) shall retire from office by rotation provided that every Director shall be subject to retirement at least once every three years. Pursuant to Article 84(2) of the Articles, a retiring Director shall be eligible for re-election and shall continue to act as a Director throughout the meeting at which he retires.

As such, each of Mr. Zheng Yongxiang and Mr. Wong Tak Shing will retire at the Annual General Meeting and, being eligible, will offer himself for re-election.

Particulars of Mr. Zheng Yongxiang and Mr. Wong Tak Shing are set out in Appendix II of this circular.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Notice is set out on pages N1 to N5 of this circular.

The 2025 Annual Report incorporating the audited consolidated financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2025 and the reports of the Directors and the auditor thereon has been dispatched to the Shareholders in accordance with the Listing Rules.

A form of proxy for use at the Annual General Meeting is enclosed with this circular. Whether or not you are able to attend the Annual General Meeting in person, you are requested to complete the accompanying form of proxy in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and deposit the same with the Company's Hong Kong share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, as soon as possible and in any event not later than 48 hours before the commencement of the Annual General Meeting or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the Annual General Meeting or any adjournment thereof should you so wish.

VOTING BY POLL AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Pursuant to Rule 13.39 of the Listing Rules, all votes of the Shareholders at the general meetings must be taken by poll. The chairman of the Annual General Meeting will therefore demand a poll for every resolution put to the vote of the Annual General Meeting pursuant to Article 66 of the Articles.

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors believe that the proposed grants of the Mandates and re-election of the retiring Directors named above are in the interest of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

Accordingly, the Directors recommend that the Shareholders vote in favour of the resolutions for approving the grant of the Mandates and the re-election of the retiring Directors at the Annual General Meeting.

CLOSURE OF REGISTER OF MEMBERS

For the purpose of determining the Shareholders' eligibility to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting, the register of members of the Company will be closed from Monday, 1 June 2026 to Thursday, 4 June 2026 (both days inclusive), during which period no transfer of shares will be registered. In order to be entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting, all transfer documents accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's Hong Kong share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong for registration no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, 29 May 2026.

This Appendix I serves as an explanatory statement, as required by the Listing Rules, to provide the requisite information as to the proposed Repurchase Mandate.

1. LISTING RULES RELATING TO THE REPURCHASE OF SHARES

The Listing Rules permit companies whose primary listing is on the Stock Exchange to repurchase their shares on the Stock Exchange and any other stock exchange on which the securities of the company are listed and such exchange is recognised by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange subject to certain restrictions. Among such restrictions, the Listing Rules provide that the shares of such company must be fully paid up and all repurchase of shares by such company must be approved in advance by an ordinary resolution of shareholders, either by way of a general repurchase mandate or by specific approval of a particular transaction.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, there were a total of 125,235,000 Shares in issue, and the Company did not have any treasury Shares. Subject to the passing of the proposed resolution granting the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 12,523,500 Shares, which represents 10% of the entire issued share capital of the Company (excluding any treasury Shares) as at the date of passing the resolution until the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; or
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required by the Articles or the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands to be held; or
- (iii) revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in a general meeting.

The Company may cancel such repurchased Shares or hold them as treasury Shares, subject to market conditions and the Group's capital management needs at the relevant time of the repurchases.

For any treasury Shares deposited with Central Clearing and Settlement System used within the market system of Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited ("CCASS"), the Company shall (i) procure its broker not to give any instructions to Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited to vote at general meetings of the Company for the treasury Shares deposited with CCASS; and (ii) in the case of dividends or distributions, withdraw the treasury Shares from CCASS, and either re-register them in its own name as treasury Shares or cancel them, in each case before the record date for the dividends or distributions, or take any other measures to ensure that it will not exercise any shareholders' rights or receive any entitlements which would otherwise be suspended under the applicable laws if those Shares were registered in its own name as treasury Shares.

3. REASONS FOR THE REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that it is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole to seek a general authority from the Shareholders to enable the Company to repurchase the Shares on the Stock Exchange or any other stock exchange on which the Shares may be listed. Share repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

4. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing the Shares, the Company may only apply funds legally available for the purpose in accordance with the Articles and the Companies Act.

Taking into account the current working capital position of the Company, the Directors consider that, if the Repurchase Mandate was to be exercised in full, it might have a material adverse effect on the working capital and/or the gearing position of the Company (as compared with the financial position of the Company as at 31 December 2025 as disclosed in its latest financial statements contained in the 2025 Annual Report). However, the Directors do not intend to make any repurchases to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements or the gearing position of the Company. The amount of premium payable on a repurchase of Shares may only be paid out of either the profits or out of the share premium of the Company or out of the capital of the Company.

6. THE TAKEOVERS CODE AND MINIMUM PUBLIC HOLDING

If a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases when the Company exercises its powers to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder or group of Shareholders acting in concert could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 or Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, as far as the Directors are aware, substantial shareholders of the Company having an interest in 10% or more in the issued share capital of the Company are as follows:

As at the Latest Practicable Date, to the best knowledge of the Directors, the controlling shareholders (as defined in the Listing Rules) of the Company, namely Mr. Zheng Hong and Popular Trend Holdings Limited (the “**Controlling Shareholders**”), together control the exercise of 41.07% voting rights in the general meeting of the Company.

In the event that the Directors should exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares which is proposed to be granted pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, the attributable interest of the Controlling Shareholders in the Company would increase to approximately 45.63% of the issued share capital of the Company. As a result, Mr. Zheng Hong and Popular Trend Holdings Limited (and persons acting in concert with each of them) may be required to make a mandatory offer under Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code. The Company has no intention to repurchase Shares to such extent that an obligation to make a general offer under the Takeovers Code will be triggered.

The Directors will not exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent that will result in the number of Shares in the hands of public falling below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25%.

7. SHARE REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company had not purchased any of its Shares (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise) during the previous six months preceding the Latest Practicable Date.

8. GENERAL

None of the Directors, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, nor any of their associates has any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company if the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Directors will exercise the power of the Company to make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules, the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and the regulations set out in the Articles.

The Directors confirmed that neither this explanatory statement nor the proposed Repurchase Mandate has any unusual features.

No core connected person of the Company has notified the Company that he has a present intention to sell any Shares to the Company nor has any such core connected person undertaken not to sell any Shares held by him to the Company in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is granted.

The details of the retiring Directors eligible and offering themselves for re-election at the Annual General Meeting are set out below:

Mr. Zheng Yongxiang

Zheng Yongxiang (鄭永祥), aged 57, was appointed as an executive Director on 4 May 2011. Mr. Zheng Yongxiang has over 24 years of experience in the textile industry. He has been a director of Jinyuan Textile Company Limited, Jiangxi (“**Jiangxi Jinyuan**”), Jolly Success International Limited and Treasure Resource Corporation Limited since 2005, 2011 and 2013 respectively. He joined Jiangxi Jinyuan in 2005 as a general manager and is primarily responsible for formulating the policy and monitoring the operation of the Group. Prior to joining Jiangxi Jinyuan, Mr. Zheng Yongxiang served as the general manager of Shaoxing Gangtai Weaving Company Limited (紹興港泰針紡有限公司) from 2001 to 2005. He received the award of Outstanding Entrepreneur in 2007 (2007年度優秀企業家) from the Yichun Municipal People’s Government in 2008 and was awarded the Outstanding Architects of Yichun in the Reforming and Open Up for 30 Years (改革開放30年宜春市優秀建設者) in 2008 and the Best Ten Yichun Citizen (十佳宜春人) in 2009. He was the Chairman of Federation of Industry and Commerce of Fengxin County, Jiangxi Province (江西省奉新縣工商業聯合會) from 2012 to 2015. Mr. Zheng Yongxiang was a representative of Jiangxi Fengxin County People’s Congress (江西省奉新縣人民代表大會) from 2015 to 2022. Mr. Zheng Yongxiang graduated from the Open University of China (中央廣播電視大學) with a diploma of accounting (finance and accounting) in 2010. Mr. Zheng Yongxiang is the elder brother of Mr. Zheng Hong, the chairman and the non-executive Director of the Company.

Save as disclosed above, Mr. Zheng has not held any other directorships in other listed public companies in the past three years and does not hold any other position with the Company and other members of the Group.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Zheng was interested or deemed to be interested, within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO, in 22,447,720 Shares, representing approximately 17.92% of the issued share capital of the Company. Save as aforementioned, Mr. Zheng was not interested or deemed to be interested in any Shares or underlying Shares within the meaning of Part XV of the SFO.

Mr. Zheng has entered into a service contract with the Company for a term of three years commencing from 3 December 2023 and may be terminated by not less than three months’ prior notice in writing served by either party on the other. Mr. Zheng’s emoluments recorded in 2025 was approximately RMB1,128,000, including salaries and contribution to pension scheme, with reference to his experience, workload and time devoted to the Group.

Mr. Wong Tak Shing

Wong Tak Shing (黃德盛), aged 63, was appointed as an independent non-executive Director on 27 November 2023. Mr. Wong has over 30 years of experience in accounting, corporate finance, personnel and administration. Mr. Wong is currently an independent non-executive Director of Beijing Chunlizhengda Medical Instruments Co., Ltd. (Stock Code 1858), a company listed on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”). Mr. Wong was previously an executive director of China Ocean Fishing Holdings Limited (Stock Code: 8047), an independent non-executive director of Pa Shun International Holdings Limited (Stock Code: 0574), and Digital Domain Holdings Limited (Stock Code: 0547), these companies are listed on the Stock Exchange. He was previously an independent non-executive director of China Digital Culture (Group) Limited (Stock Code: 8175), a company delisted from the Stock Exchange in May 2023.

From March 2011 to August 2019, Mr. Wong worked for Greentech Technology International Limited (Stock code: 195) with his last position as regional chief financial officer. From January 2010 to February 2011, Mr. Wong was the chief financial officer of Global Energy Resources International Group Ltd. (Stock code 8192). From April 2006 to May 2007, Mr. Wong was an executive director, the chief financial officer and company secretary of China Ocean Fishing Holdings Limited (Stock Code: 8047). Mr. Wong was a consultant of Chu Lung Hai, Jimmy & Co. CPA from January 2004 to April 2006.
